Introduction:

A limited number of partial scholarships and assistantships are awarded to incoming students in the Master of Arts in Counseling Program. All scholarships and assistantships are awarded for two years. Students in the Two-Plus Curriculum will not receive scholarship or assistantship funds in the third year of the program. The following scholarships and assistantships funds will be available for eligible students who will begin the program in academic year 2019-2020:

- Master of Arts in Counseling Program Research Assistantships
- Master of Arts in Counseling Program Support Assistantships

In addition to the aforementioned awards, the **Harris Family Scholarship** will be awarded to two incoming students. The Harris Scholarship has a separate application process. Section 3: Essay

Master of Arts in Counseling Program applicants who demonstrate financial need and who desire to gain experience as a research assistant or program support assistant are invited to apply for financial assistance from the Counseling department. The financial awards are a combination of scholarship and assistantship funds. Recipients of these awards are required to participate in either research or service activities for the duration of the time they receive financial assistance. Research and program assistants are encouraged to participate in a service or research activity that is meaningful to their individual educational and career goals. The time commitment is typically in the range of two to six hours per week.

Assistantship awards are based on the following criteria:

1. Financial need

- 2. Desire to incorporate research and programming in future/career path
- 3. Level of experience with research
- 4. Level of experience with program/project support
- 5. Oral and written communication skills
- 6. Time management & organizational skills
- 7. Demonstrated ability to work as part of a team
- 8. Intermediate to advanced PC skills
